2. OUTLINE

These Terms of Reference outline the minimum Scope of Work for which the Service Provider (Contractor) is responsible. It defines key activities and what the Contractor is responsible for delivering i.e. the required outcomes as a result of the fencing activities.

3. BACKGOUND

Winnie Madikizela Mandela Local Municipality falls within the jurisdiction of Alfred Nzo District of the Eastern Cape Province.
