TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.Sector to be Capacitated	Community Structures for Manufacturing Hubs
2. Duration	6 days
3. Introduction & Background	Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality (WMMLM) in partnership with the Alfred Nzo District Municipality (ANDM) is implementing the Winnie Madikizela-Manufacturing hubs project located with the jurisdiction of the local municipality. This is a strategic project which seeks to reduce leakages prevailing within the manufacturing sector. Ward 4, ward 8 and ward 16 have been identified as suitable and strategic wards for the implementation of this project. The project will be implemented in the three wards subject to compliant feasibility studies. The main objective of the project is to intensify the level of production in the manufacturing sector in order to significantly improve the local and district economy, create job opportunities for the unemployed, reduce economic leakages and in turn increase contribution of the manufacturing sector to the GDP. The envisioned hubs will be technology driven and it is anticipated that the project will create 200 jobs during the construction and operational phase. Community structures have been nominated in the three wards and are fully endorsed by the
4. Needs & Objectives	community, wards councillors and traditional authorities. The community structures are not fully functional yet due to the project being in its infancy stage. However one of the key components of the project is capacity building and skills transfer. Capacity building and skills transfer will be for community structures, PSC members, project implementation members, and operational staff. A full curriculum is being developed for capacity building. All trainings are expected to be fully accredited with relevent SETA's or institutions of higher learning.
4. Needs & Objectives	The objective of the training is to capacitate community structures of the three wards on the theories, practices and elements of effective communication and leadership.
	The training will cover topics in effective communication and leadership. The training will be delivered through lectures, interactive methods, and group discussions. Due to the rural nature of our area training will be conducted physically rather than virtually and COVID-19 regulations will be followed. The training should empower community structures with relevant information that will enable them to participate in the transformation of the manufacturing sector and their communities. The training should also instil project execution principles and Improve knowledge of the manufacturing hubs project and its goals.

Besides the preparation and delivery of the course content, the training service provider will be responsible for organising and conducting the scheduled activities of the agreed training course, as well as provide the following arrangements;

- Hiring of a training facility
- Lunch meals and water during the training sessions.
