3. Introduction & Background	Winnie Madikizela Mandela Local Municipality is situated within Alfred Nzo District Municipality in the EC Province. It is located on the R61 road connecting the Kwazulu Natal (KZN) South Coastal Boundary to the N2 highway. The municipality stretches between the Umtamvuna and Mtentu Rivers, which boasts valuable flora and fauna found nowhere else in the world. It is also home to one of the greatest sons of Africa, Oliver Reginald Tambo, who was a revolutionary leader and the longest-serving ANC president.
