TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR REVIEWAL OF EXT3 DUMPING SITE CLOSURE, REHABILITATION & POST-CLOSURE MONITORING PLAN WITH FINANCIAL PROJECTIONS

1. INTRODUCTION:

Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality has identified a need to review a closure and rehabilitation plan with financial projections for the disposal site that is currently being used. This is part of the obligation to the requirement by National Environmental Management Waste Act (No 59 of 2008). This is a plan forward by the municipality to prepare for the closure of the unauthorized site and to accomplish this goal; the municipality has to provide necessary steps and financial requirements which will have to be interpreted in the annual financial statements.

2. OBJECTIVES:

- Provision of guidelines of the site status quo.
- Provide guidelines to achieve closure of the site.
- Provide for rehabilitation plan of the site.
- Provide costing for closure & rehabilitation of the site.
- Provide projected future plan for alternative use of entire rehabilitated land.

3. SCOPE OF WORK:
