## JOINT OPERATION TARGETS FOOD SAFETY IN WARD 16 SPAZA SHOPS

# HANDOVER OF MACHINERY TO MASAKHANE GROUP TO BOOST ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOB CREATION

On the 25th February 2025, the MEC for Transport, Honorable Xolile Nqatha, and Her Worship the Mayor, Cllr. Daniswa Mafumbatha attended the officially handed over the machinery to Masakhane Group in the Dudumeni community, ward 08.

The machinery that was bought by Masakhane was acquired through collaboration with SANRAL, BELL, and Standard Bank, includes a range of equipment valued at over R50 million. The package consists of a Finlay J-1175 Jaw Crusher, Finlay C-1540 Cone Crusher, Finlay 694+ Inclined Screener, two BELL B18 Articulated Dump Trucks, a JCB 455ZX Wheel Loader, and a Kobelco SK380XDL-10 Excavator.

This significant investment is expected to enhance Masakhane Group's

operational efficiency, create new job opportunities, and contribute to the economic growth of the region. The event was attended by various stakeholders, including representatives from BELL Equipment, the community, Standard Bank, the Wild Coast Business Chamber, and the SANRAL Chairman.

MEC for Transport, Mr. Xolile Nqatha, appreciated the cooperation between the Masakhane group, Sanral, Bell and Standard bank. Mr. Noshweleka, owner of Masakhane Group, appreciated the relations with the Dudumeni Community and stressed that black-owned businesses should bring opportunities to communities and contribute to economic growth. Her Worship the Mayor, Cllr. T.D. Mafumbatha, expressed gratitude to Mr. Noshweleka and the stakeholders, praising the employment opportunities created by Masakhane Group.


## Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality Empowers Community Through Education.

This program seeks to ensure that all RDP owners have ownership of their homes to curb any feuds that might occur in future. This initiative is in partnership with the Department of Human Settlements.




## MORE THAN 600 HOUSEHOLDS ARE SET TO BENEFIT FROM WATER PROJECT IN WARD 17

"Despite my excitement, I am also anxious as my identity document mistakenly identifies me as female. I have applied for rectification with the Department of Home Affairs, but I am uncertain if assistance will be forthcoming. I almost gave up in Grade 10 due to this issue, feeling demotivated without a reason to continue my studies," he recounted.

He found motivation from his elder sister, who experienced a similar issue and is now in her third year studying B. Com Accounting at Nelson Mandela University. Sinethemba achieved remarkable results, scoring 85% in IsiXhosa, 82% in English First Additional Language, 83% in Mathematics, 94% in Life Orientation, 93% in Agricultural Sciences, 92% in Life Sciences, and 84% in Physical Sciences.

Luleka Gangatha, overwhelmed by her son's achievement, shared her concerns about the tough circumstances they face.

"I am the sole provider, collecting and selling wood to support my children's education. Supporting Sinethemba has not been easy, especially with another child at Nelson Mandela University to take care of," she said. Despite their hardships, she remains committed to supporting Sinethemba in whatever path he chooses.


